Getting to Lille

By train:

Situated just 400 meters from one another, Lille's two train stations are located in the city centre and are served by both the subway and the tram.

- Lille Flandres Station: TER regional trains and direct TGV service to Paris.
- Lille Europe Station: Eurostar service to London and Brussels, direct TGV service to Roissy Airport, Paris and all major French cities.

Brussels: 38 minutes, 14 TGV and Eurostar trains a day

Paris: 1 hour, 26 direct TGVs a day

London: 80 minutes

By plane:

The Lille-Lesquin International Airport is located 10 km from Lille city centre.

It serves more than 70 national and international destinations.

Scheduled domestic flights with Air France, Aigle Azur, Air Algérie, Easyjet, HOP!, Ryanair, Tunisair, Transavia, Volotea and Vueling Companies. Direct international flights to and from: Barcelone El Prat, Genève, Venise, Agadir, Marrakech, Oujda, Porto, Alger and Oran.

Shuttle service from the airport to the city centre (bus stop sign "Liaison aéroport" outside the Euralille shopping center) is available. Length of ride: 20minutes.
